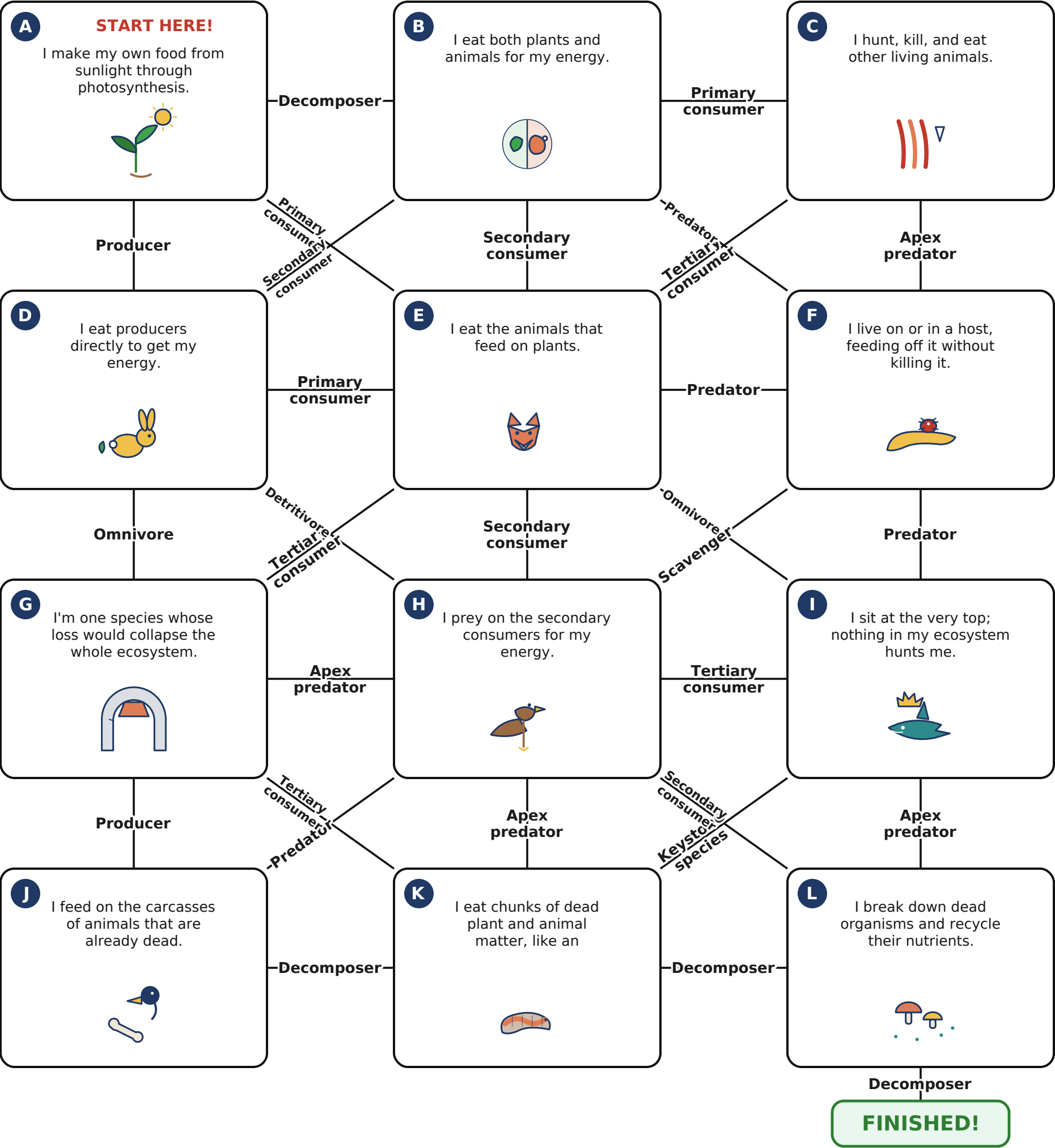


Ecology Maze

Begin at START. Name the term, then follow the path labeled with your answer. Continue until FINISHED!

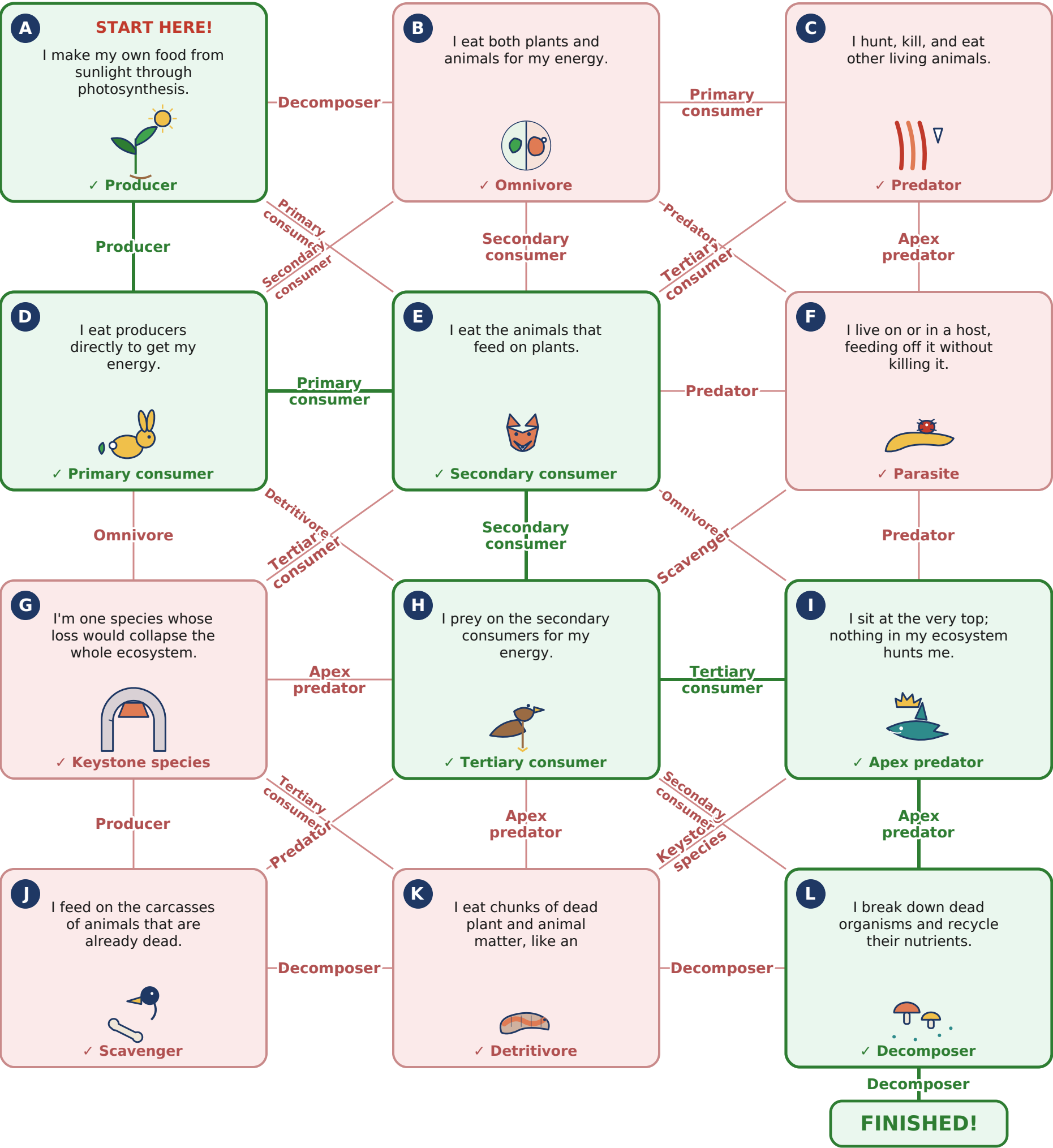


My path: → → → → → → **FINISH**

Correct path in green; pink boxes are decoys. Naming a decoy correctly dead-ends.



My path: A → D → E → H → I → L → FINISH

write each box you land on

Path: A Producer → D Primary consumer → E Secondary consumer → H Tertiary consumer → I Apex predator → L Decomposer → FINISH
